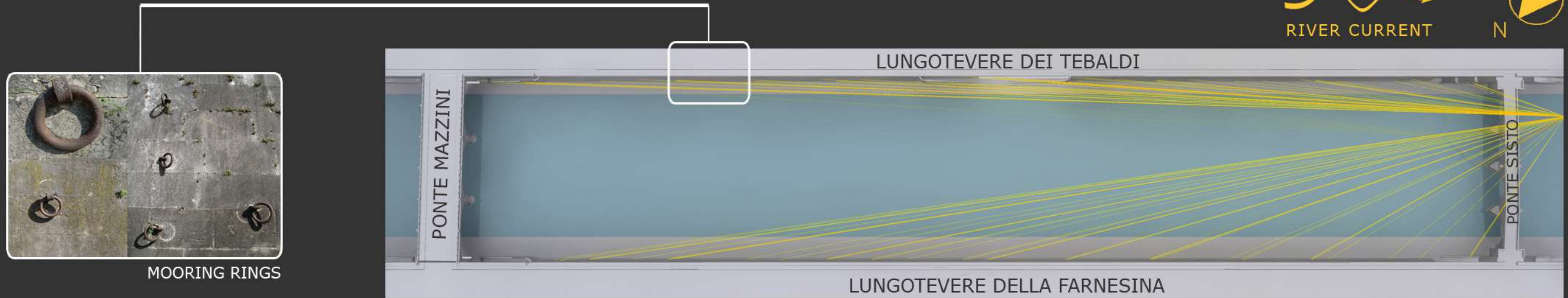

Materials: Woven Ochre Acetate Bands, Steel, Hardware
Dimensions: 722' H x 1837' L (220m H x 560m L)

Descending from an immense, gleaming pole two hundred feet above Ponte Sisto, *Aeolian* will be a luminous, geometric form spanning across the Piazza Tevere to Ponte Mazzini. Scores of brilliant, ochre ribbons will travel from a single point above, radiating down in quivering pulses of light and color to meet each of the bronze nineteenth-century mooring rings along the river's embankment walls, evoking the ancient maypole ritual celebrating spring.

Piercing through Tiber's surface like a bolt of lightning thrust from the sky, the pointed taper will be visible throughout the center of historic Rome. Like a harp, each band will resonate, moved by the wind's fluid currents. The aerial form will create a golden haze, shifting against the sky and reflecting onto the water below.
